**24/131 Public Discussion and Public Questions**

**24/132 Acceptance of Office**

**24/135 Planning Applications**

**P25/S0010/FUL - Farm Buildings at Little Sandhill, Standhill Lane, Little Haseley, OX44 7LW** - Conversion of buildings to residential self-build dwelling (as an improved alternative to conversion permitted under P24/S1452/N4B - to include timber cladding, infill area, flue, solar panels, ASHP and battery).

**Resolved to Not to Object** provided the proposals do not invalidate those already permitted under class Q regulations.

It was noted that £128.60 is forward funding to purchase hedging which will be repaid by a grant from Trust for Oxfordshire Environment (ToE).

**History / Parish Council shed**

It was agreed that a tin cover will be put over the roof to stop water ingress into the shed at an approximate cost of £250.00.

It was noted that a County Council Gulley Clearance Contractor had tried to clear a drain on Mil Lane but could not lift the drain cover due to a tree root growing in the drain. Agreed the Clerk will contact Highways Engagement and ask that the root is removed.
